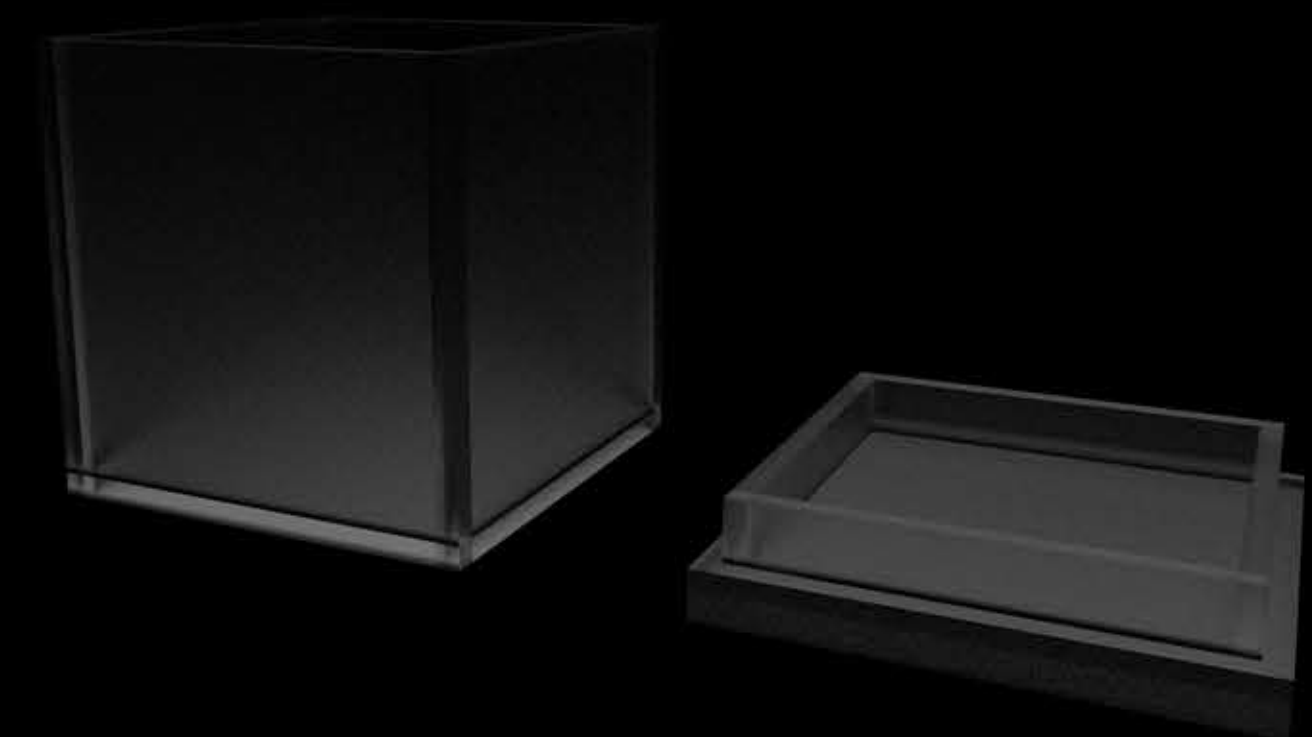


The Moon Gallery is a program for defining and promoting the evolution of an aesthetic organism. The three main components of this program are research , collaboration and archive.

Each participant in the Moon Gallery must submit an Idea for an Art work or idea to be placed in a 1 x 1 x 1 cm cube.

The questions we ask participants to think about and address in thier proposal text is the overall message you want to archive for future generations and how is the object or work of art a symbol of this message?



The Research component is directed toward the development of context, informative materials and structure for the promotion of a call for artistic submissions.

The Collaboration component is the implementation of the online creative tool and website designed for collecting submissions and showing a real-time evolution of the 'aesthetic organism'.

The Archive component is both the dissemination of an online resource of images and artist proposals along with a possibly random selection of proposals fabricated into an actual material installation on the moon surface in the 10 x 10 x 1 cm grid format.
